

Boxborough's Dog Officer and the Board of Selectmen would like to remind dog owners to respect the town's dog control bylaw.

- Dogs do not have to be on leash if they can be kept under voice control. If your dog does not stay at your side or will not return to you when called, under all circumstances, he/she should be kept on a leash for everyone's safety including the dogs.
- Boxborough has wonderful town-owned land - woods, ponds, open land and trails to use. Dogs must stay with you and be kept under control while on these properties.
- With the increasing use of the town property by dogs and their owners please remember to clean up after your dog. Thanks to a Boxborough Eagle Scout project, several properties have a station at the entrance with a trashcan for disposal, and a bag dispenser for your convenience. However, it is always a good idea to come prepared with your own bags.
